



**Aldo Chircop**, JSD, is Professor of Law and former Canada Research Chair in Maritime Law and Policy (Tier I), Schulich School of Law, Dalhousie University. Professor Chircop is Chair of the International Working Group on Polar Shipping of the Comité Maritime International. Originally from Malta, he his career has spanned four decades, including 32 years at Dalhousie. Throughout his career, Professor Chircop lectured and examined at numerous universities in the Americas, Asia, and Europe. He was director of several institutes, including the International Ocean Institute in Malta, and the Marine & Environmental Law Institute at Schulich. He was also Canadian Chair in Marine Environment Protection and head of the ocean management specialization at the IMO World Maritime University in Sweden. Professor Chircop has received numerous competitive research grants in Canada and overseas. His research interests are in the fields of Canadian and international maritime law, international law of the sea, international environmental law, and Arctic shipping. He has published extensively on maritime law and the law of the sea and has received several academic and professional awards, including in maritime law by the Canadian Bar Association.
