Professor Fumiko MASUDA is a Professor of Commercial Law at the Faculty of Humanities and Social Sciences (Law), Okayama University. She graduated from Kyoto University with an LL.B. in 2000 and became an Associate Professor of International Business Law there in 2003, serving until September 2015. She received her Magister Juris (MJur) from the University of Oxford in 2006.

Her main research interests lie in the comparative analysis of maritime and transport law, as well as related issues in private international law. She contributed to the revision of Japanese transport and maritime law that came into force in 2019, serving as a member of the Working Group on Commercial (Transport and Maritime) Law under the Legislative Council to the Minister of Justice of Japan from April 2014 to February 2016. She has published extensively on maritime and transport law, primarily in Japanese. She is a co-author of the Japanese national report in *Legal Aspects of Cruises* (ed. Cecilia Fresnedo de Aguirre, Springer, 2022).
