Prof. Gertjan van der Ziel worked for the Netherlands' Ministry of Transport and was, thereafter, for many years General Counsel of transportation companies (a.o. Nedlloyd, European Rail Shuttle), Professor of Transportation Law at Erasmus University Rotterdam and Maritime Arbitrator.

He participated in the preparations of the Rotterdam Rules as Member of UNCITRAL Expert Group on Transport Law and as Head of the Netherlands' delegation to UNCITRAL. He is Member of the CMI Standing Committee on the Ratification of the Rotterdam Rules and former Chairman of the Netherlands' Association of Transport Law.

He is the author (with Michael Sturley and Tomotaka Fujita) of the treatise on the Rotterdam Rules "THE ROTTERDAM RULES: The UN Convention on Contracts for the International Carriage of Goods Wholly or Partly by Sea".
