


SERVING THE RULE OF INTERNATIONAL MARITIME LAW



IMLI's purpose

IMLI was established in Malta to assist Governments, particularly from developing countries, in building up both their human and institutional capacities in the full spectrum of international maritime law for the uniform and effective implementation of international maritime rules and regulations, especially those adopted by IMO.





IMLI's Role IMLI's role has since then developed to train maritime professionals from all over the world, <u>whether they come from developing or developed</u> <u>countries</u>, and <u>whether they work for the</u> <u>government or in the maritime industry</u>.



IMLI Master's Programmes

- Master of Laws (LL.M.) in International Maritime Law;
- Master of Humanities (M.Hum.) in International Maritime Legislation;
- Master of Philosophy (M.Phil.) in International Maritime Law / Legislation and ocean Policy (jointly with WMU).





Other Programmes

- A Research Degree programme leading to the award of the Degree of Magister Juris (M.Jur.) in International Maritime Law and the Degree of Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) in International Maritime Law;
- Advanced Diploma programme in International Maritime Law;
- Short courses in the different areas of the Institute's academic syllabus;
- > Tailor-made courses as required.

Unique Nature of Legal Training at IMLI



IMLI's programmes are unique in that they cover in-depth the whole spectrum of international maritime law, including:

- Shipping Law;
- Law of the Sea;
- Marine Environmental Law; and
- > International Maritime Security Law.



Maritime Legislation Drafting

- IMLI's programmes offer a dedicated course on maritime legislation drafting.
- In January 2025 IMO organized at IMLI for the very first time its capacitybuilding workshop entitled "Drafting for Drafters".
- The workshop which was usually delivered at IMO Headquarters by IMO officers and external consultants was delivered to the IMLI students as part of the academic year.

Promotion of Gender Equality

Since its inception the Institute has been at the forefront of the promotion of Gender Equality by adopting a policy in its Statute that up to fifty per cent of admissions are reserved for women.





Provision of fellowships


IMLI relies on its donors to provide fellowships to candidates from IMO Member States;


The call for applications is generally issued in October/November and closes around February/March.

The only requirement is that the relevant nomination is made through the Permanent Representation at IMO.


IMLI's Contribution to the International Maritime Community
