Professor Fujita is the President of Japanese Maritime Law Association and a Titularly Member of CMI. He serves as a member of CMI Executive Council 2012-2018 and the Chair of Standing Committee on Carriage of Goods. He is also a member of Nominating



Committee and various International Working Groups including Judicial Sales of Ships and Lex Maritima. Professor Fujita participated in the Japanese Delegation to international organizations including United Nations Commission on International Trade Law (UNCITRAL), International Maritime Organization (IMO) and International Oil Pollution Compensation Funds (IOPC Funds). He was a Vice Chair of the UNCITRAL 41st Session (2008) and First Vice Chair of the 1992 IOPC Fund Assembly since 2009. Professor Fujita is the author of *THE ROTTERDAM RULES: THE UN CONVENTION ON CONTRACTS FOR THE INTERNATIONAL CARRIAGE OF GOODS WHOLLY OR PARTLY BY SEA*, SWEET AND MAXWELL, 2ND 2020.
